Dear People of Galilee,

In Galilee Church's library we all came together after cleaning in all different corners of the church and the church grounds, and we sat down to share a big pot of chili. We came in from the playground, and people came in from the sanctuary, they came from the basement of the church, and from the basketball hoop from sweeping the street and raking the leaves. We came in from the kitchen where we sanitized everything and cleaned out the refrigerator. We came from the offices, and came in from the walk in closet. And when we had all settled in and were all eating, I looked around, and the room was absolutely full. There are so many people around the tables in the library that we had to bring in a couple of folding chairs. I ate on the corner of the table because it was so beautifully filled with people that in order to all fit, we did that. What a wonderful, wonderful feeling to be together again. I thought maybe the tongues of the Holy Spirit were probably resting upon each of us, bringing all together like that. It felt like a scene from the Acts of the Apostles, chapter two: When the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place. And suddenly from heaven there came a sound like the rush of.... wind, and it filled the entire house where they were sitting. Divided tongues, as of fire, appeared among them, and a tongue rested on each of them. All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit.

I am so grateful to be gathered all together with you in one place. This is nothing less than Pentecost. Nothing less than the Holy Spirit drawing us together. The Lord is with you. The Lord got you out of bed this morning and brought you here, so that we would all be together praising the Lord, for the Lord is good, his love endures forever.

Rest in peace, dear friend, who is missed by all who were fortunate enough to know Duane.


Thank you to all who volunteer to keep Galilee in good repair, especially Steve, Joe and Abe, who worked to replace the mailbox that was destroyed in June.

## Not on My Block Peace Walk

Thank you everyone for coming out to walk with Mothers Against Community Gun Violence (MACGV) June 13, as we stood with and for community mothers and members who have lost a child to gun violence. Thank you especially Thomas, Jane, Tom, and Anthony. "This gathering gave a supportive, healing platform for grieving families as well as neighbors, clergy, faith community members, children, and concerned citizens to come together to hear the stories of loss and of healing, with the aim to slow down the senseless violence. One of the mothers just lost her 15 year old daughter two months ago. She linked arms with a half a dozen other moms also carrying poster boards with pictures of their own children's faces on them. LaTanya, mother of a 22 year old who was killed on the corner of Rice and Larpenteur last summer, had these words to say, "The loss of a child is earth-shattering and then compound that hurt and devastation with having to live with your child being taken away in a violent incomprehensible way; No parent should have to endure that type of mental or physical anguish. If you, anyone you know, or if you're a concerned individual who cares about the community, people, and the right to LIFE come "Peace Walk" with us tomorrow for the change we want to see in all communities. Healthy communities, healthy people!"
