### Uhominyi Scholarships

We have been able to support 11 students in Uhominyi, our companion congregation, for the last years. In a wonderful Zoom meeting in August, we discovered that there are now 20 students who need money to attend secondary school. Primary school is free in Iringa, but there is a fee for secondary school which is usually a boarding school. Our average fee is about \$375 per year per student. The nearest school to Uhominyi is Image which is only a few kilometers away. It has four years of secondary school. There is also a year 5 and year 6 which is like our junior college, but those schools are farther away. Students also have to pass a difficult test to be admitted into Level 5. It would be great if we could give all 20 students the opportunity to get the education that they so earnestly desire.

If you would like to donate money for scholarships in any amount, include a check to Galilee in your offering envelope and write "Scholarships" on the envelope. The money goes to the Saint Paul Area Synod and they send it to Tanzania through very safe channels. We get reports and pictures of the students every year. You may see the latest pictures on the bulletin board in the Fellowship Hall. We would like to get the contributions by the end of November.
