Zoom gatherings Wednesdays at 2 p.m!

Welcome everyone! Each Wednesday we will listen to a new story by the people of our congregation, about what makes you happy and brings you joy. The whole church is invited via a Zoom link to join in on these meetings. It is heartwarming to "be together" with our Galilee family even if they are far away, up at a cabin with wifi, or at home.

These meetings last just 45 minutes - (because Zoom is free for up to 45 minutes), and in addition to the sharing about what brings joy, I share Bible stories and Bible verses related to the stories. I especially highlight parts of the Bible that we don't get to hear on Sunday mornings. There are Bible stories that are "not in the lectionary", so unless you read them on your own at home, we don't get a chance to learn very much about these fascinating stories in the Bible. So be sure to bring your Bible to these Zoom times. What brings you joy? What makes you happy? What is helping you during this Covid-19 difficult time? For some it is swimming or knitting, gardening, watching comedy TV shows, connecting with grandchildren, listening to African Reggae music, volunteering at food drives, cooking new recipes, praying and meditating, dancing... Tell us all about it! We want to hear you.

My prayer is that each Wednesday we bring life, light, hope, help into our lives together through Zoom. During this time of isolation during this pandemic we know too well many of us, or our friends, loved ones, family members and church family sisters and brothers are experiencing depression, grief, loneliness, anxiety, and much suffering as a result of so many people getting sick and dying. This pandemic puts a strain on youth, and on families and relationships as we are stuck at home together and have not been able to go out and be in school or with friends. It also is extremely hard on those who live alone and those who live in care centers. It's hard on the whole world!

And so, these Zoom gathering meetings are going to accentuate the positive! We are listening to our fellow Gallieans share what makes them happy, and what brings them joy, and as your pastor I will supplement it with interesting Bible reading! Please join us!

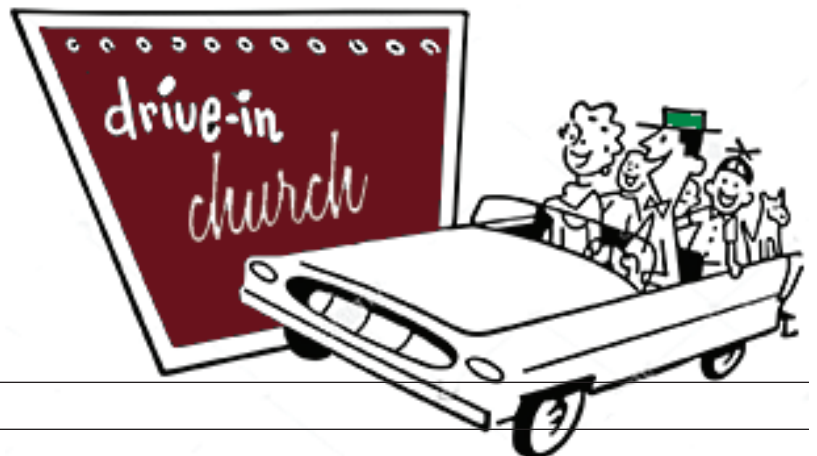

Once again, thank you so much for your financial support during the time when we could not meet together and now as we rejoice to meet in the parking lot. We are very grateful for all that you do!

This amount is able to meet our expenses for the month.

In May we also received \$2,000 from the Saint Paul Area Synod to help us during the time of COVID-19.

Total thus far for June is \$10,131.42. This is a great start for June.

We have been blessed to receive a check from the Lois LaVon Brase estate for \$40,625 which is designated for Outreach. What wonderful opportunities we now have to be able to help so many. Even after their deaths, Lois LaVon and Herb continue to be helping others just as they did in life. I will never forget when they opened their entire basement in the 1970's to an entire refugee family from Vietnam teaching them everything about adjustment to life in the US and hosting them for months. Thank you so, so very much for helping us out yesterday. We were blown away; this was your largest drive yet. We were able to collect 41 units of blood at your drive, which translates to 123 potential lives saved! That's incredible! The staff also wanted to thank you for providing volunteer help. Your total is now a potential 288 lives saved and counting.

We'll be looking forward to you next drive on July 8.

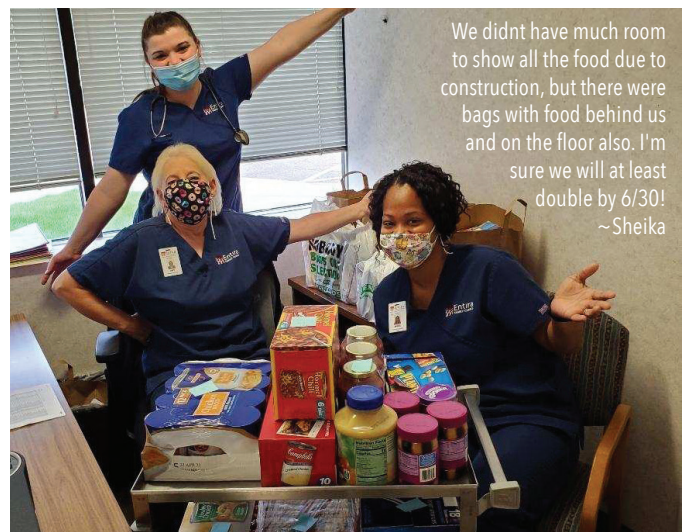
Entira Food Drive
