HONOR FLIGHT TWIN CITIES


In May of 2004, our nation completed the construction of the World War II Memorial in Washington D.C. to commemorate the sacrifices of the "Greatest Generation." Sadly, because of their age, financial constraints or health concerns many of these veterans may not have an opportnity to see their monument. Honor Flight Twin Cities is happy to offer free flights to World War II, Korean War, and Vietnam Veterans to Washington D.C. to see their monuments.

This year Galilee member Wayne Christensen was included in this special day of honoring our Veterans. His daughter Janet accompanied him.

Since inception, 223,000+ Veterans and 162,000+ Guardians from across the United States have been safely transported as guests of Honor Flight. The 501c(3) non-profit Honor Flight Twin Cities is in partnership with the National Honor Flight



Organization. The 25th Honor Flight took place on May 6th (sponsored by HFTC for MN & W. WI). The Veterans and Guardians left the Mpls/St Paul Airport at 6am and returned at 10pm. The group either drove or walked by the Air Force Memorial, US Capitol, Navy Memorial, WW II Memorial, (where a group picture was taken), Korea Memorial, Lincoln Memorial, Vietnam Veterans Memorial, FDR Memorial, Iwo Jima monument & Women's Memorial. They also saw the impressive Changing of the Guard at Arlington Cemetery's Tomb of the Unknown Soldier.

A Homecoming Party was waiting for them when they returned to the Twin Cities, with many friends and loved ones greeting them.

In the 16 years since the first flight in 2008, Honor Flight Twin Cities has had 25 flights with 5,000 participants and has sponsored 130 flyovers. This year 78 trained Guardians personally escorted the 78 Veterans and accompanied them throughout the day. The program operates on donations from organizations and individuals.
