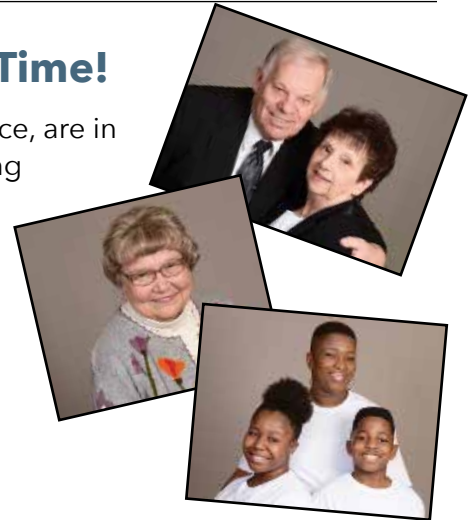

Emerald Ash Borer is an invasive insect that has attacked and destroyed twelve trees on Galilee's property.

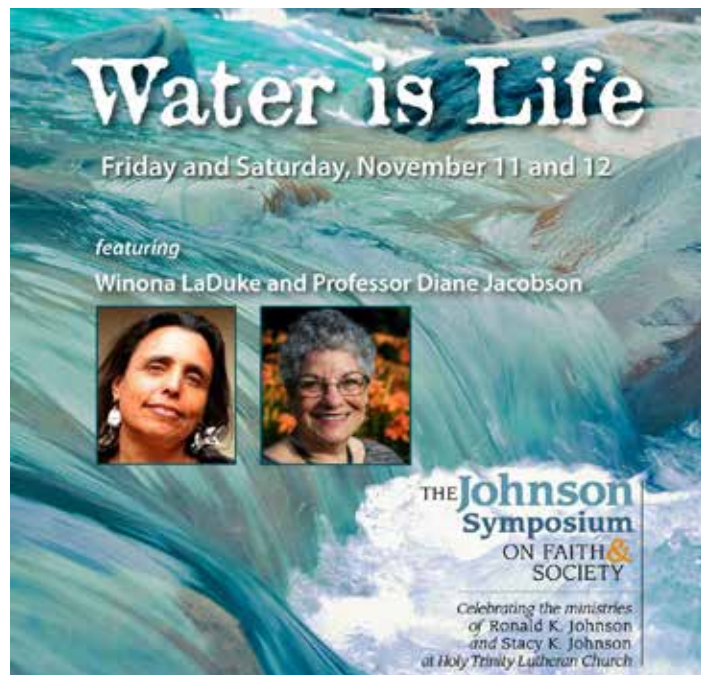
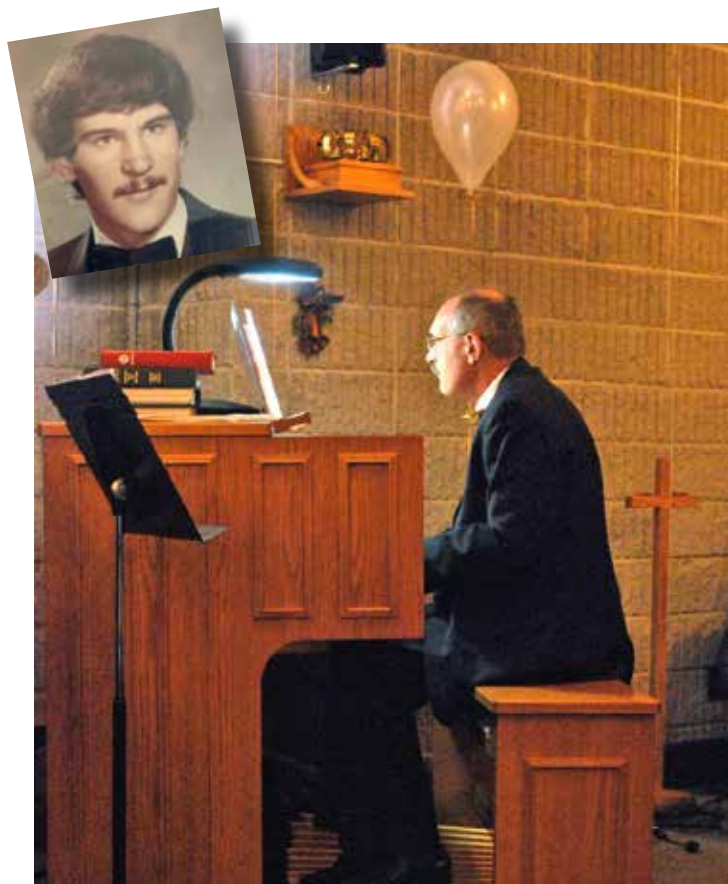
