



Scriptural Themes: Our campaign is grounded in the wisdom of Proverbs 16:

"Commit your work to the Lord, and your plans will be established" (v.3)

"The human mind plans the way, but the Lord directs the steps" (v. 9).

"Sometimes there is a way that seems right, but in the end it is the way of death" (v. 25).

The theme of Proverbs, echoed throughout the wisdom literature (Job, Ecclesiastes, Psalms, Proverbs, Sirach, Song of Solomon), is clear:

- God oversees all things with sovereign direction.
- We are given the freedom to plan, but our plans are best entrusted to God's care.
- Through prayer and Spirit-led decisions, we live out God's justice, generosity, and love.

As baptized Christians, we believe the Holy Spirit inspires our generosity, guiding us in faith and in giving. Financial pledges are not only practical support for our mission—they are faith commitments to glorify God and bless our neighbors.
