BIBLE TRANSLATIONS:

If you have been noticing differences with the words of Scripture verses in the pre-printed Sunday bulletin compared to what is heard from the lectern/pulpit Bible, then you are correct! The lectern/pulpit Bible is the 1989 New Revised Standard Version translation (NRSV). Before and since 1989 there have been discoveries of historical significance and witness of ancient manuscripts. These documents with further research study expanded the insight and greater understanding of the writings and cultures that produced the NRSV. This expansion has become the New Revised Standard Version Updated Edition (NRSVue) translation which is the Biblical/Scriptural content of the weekly pre-printed Sunday bulletin. The NRSVue translation has been lauded for increased readability, accessibility, and inclusivity. A new lectern Bible will be needed.

Thank you Terry, Steve, Darla, CarolAnn and Altar Guild for tree decorating. Fabulous job!


AROUND OUR CHURCH
