Galilee Members and Friends.

Please receive my gratitude for your caring love with the kindness of our Christians disciplines and gifts (listening, prayers, spoken, and written condolences and sympathies) in the death of my mother, Betty. On returning to ministry on Saturday, February 22, after my absence from Galilee (Feb. 13 to 21), I joined six Call Committee and Council members at the St. Paul Area Synod (SPAS) Conference Assembly and Tool Kit in Apple Valley hosted by Shepherd of the Valley. The SPAS Toolkit offered presenters on ministry concerns and matters related to congregational faith, life, and community. At the North Central Conference assembly, Galilee had the most congregation voters attending. Galilee joined in reelecting Conference Dean, The Reverend Ivy Huston, pastor of Living Waters Lutheran Church, Lino Lakes, and unanimously voting to forward the ENGAGE resolution on gun safe actions (promoted by SPAS congregations) to the May 16-17 SPAS assembly. ENGAGE is a SPAS public witness committee on gun violence prevention (GVP). Their mission is to meditate on, educate about, and advocate for gun violence prevention in the non-violent Spirit of Jesus. After our worship of word (sung and spoken) and prayer, we participated in the following workshops: Centering Prayer, Shared Ministry, Becoming an Effective Treasurer, Embodied Practices for Social Justice, Decision or Discernment, and Healing Nature Trails. Expect to hear in March about these presentations from the Galilee participants.

Liturgical life at Galilee: Lent is the season of thanksgiving and praise for our gift of holy baptism and our call to live as a baptized community. Lent, meaning springtime, begins with Ash Wednesday worship on Wednesday, March 5 at 4:00 p.m.

Community Ministry Matters: With two or more members of Galilee, I look forward to meeting in the Galilee parking lot at 5:15 to carpool to attend the Rice and Larpenteur (3 cities.1 Neighborhood) Community Gathering on Tuesday, March 4th 5:30-7 pm.


